It is that special time of the year again when we set ourselves apart to seek the Lord through fasting and prayer – it is time for 40 Days of Power. This is a sacred season for the members of the International Central Gospel Church (ICGC) and many Christians across various denominations, that participate in this 40-day period of seeking God's face in a corporate fast. Over the years it has been my great joy and honour to lead God's people on this spiritual journey. I continually praise God as I witness His people joining their hearts in faith and prayer – and as I behold His faithfulness manifested in many answered prayers.

The theme for ICGC in 2025 is 'Jesus'. From the beginning of this year, and through to its end, we have set our focus on the foundation and centre of our Christian faith – Christ Jesus. We are committed to deepening our knowledge of His person, His purpose, His principles, His provision and His power. This season of consecration is a divine opportunity for each one of us to reaffirm Jesus as our Lord and Saviour and to draw nearer to Him. As we do, we will receive His

sufficient grace, through His Spirit, to live lives of purpose and victory. As Scripture declares "And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace." (John 1:16). There will be an outpouring of grace as we pray in faith.

This year's 40 Days of Power begins from Thursday, 26th June 2025, and ends on Monday, 4th August 2025. Throughout this period, we will spend time praying about our personal lives, our families, the church, and the nations of the world.

Various ICGC assemblies will host in-person prayer services. You are welcome to visit any assembly for personal prayer or to join others in corporate prayer at various advertised service times.

This prayer guide will be a helpful companion for you during the 40-day period. It includes weekly themes and daily sub-themes, each supported with relevant scriptures for reflection. It also provides a biblical basis to pray in accordance with God's word. With this guide, you can pray with focus on a wide array of topics covering diverse themes. Various declarations have been included for confession, to make each day's prayers even more meaningful.

As always, endeavour to fast wisely with thoughtful consideration for your health and wellbeing. Read and apply the helpful tips on effective fasting that have been included in this guide.

As you embark on this spiritual journey, may your knowledge of Jesus, our reigning King, increase! May He grant you many testimonies of answered prayer!

HELPFUL HINTS FOR FASTING

The practice of regular fasting is a normal Christian discipline taught by Jesus. In **Matthew** 6:16–18, Jesus provided guidelines for fasting. Fasting was also practiced by the early church as evidenced in **Acts** 13:2. It has been a lifestyle for believers throughout church history.

Fasting has physical as well as spiritual benefits. It must be embarked on with spiritual commitment and wisdom, with a heart's desire to glorify God.

Do's Of Fasting

- 1. It is best to prepare your body for the fast by cutting back on food portions and eating smaller meals. This will help your body adjust more easily to the change in meal times.
- 2. Prevent constipation during and after the fast by eating fresh fruit and raw vegetables, fruit or vegetable juices, oatmeal, and so on.
- 3. Drink lots of water as you fast.
- 4. Seek medical advice before the fast if you have any existing health conditions.
- 5. You can fast in different ways. For example, a Daniel fast is one in which you consume only vegetables and water throughout the fast. Prayerfully seek God's face concerning the kind of fast you would wish to embark on.
- 6. Have a clear target as your prayer focus. Scripture teaches that without a vision or clear goal, the people perish (Proverbs 29:18). Write down your vision for the fast so you can run with it (Habakkuk 2:2).
- 7. Take time to pray and read God's Word. This may seem obvious, but busyness and distractions can keep you from daily devotions. Expect to hear God's voice as you read His word, through dreams, visions, and revelations as He wills. Daniel prepared himself to receive revelation through fasting (Daniel 10:1–2).
- 8. Break your fast gradually. At this point you will need to exercise watchful self-control. Break your fast on a meal that is light and easy to digest (i.e., broth, shredded apples, watermelon, or steamed vegetables).
- 9. Anticipate spiritual opposition. Satan tempted Jesus while He fasted, and we must not be surprised if we face the same. Discouragement may come, but take your stand on the victory of Christ.

Don'ts Of Fasting

- 1. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods during the fast.
- 2. Abstain from strong stimulants such as caffeinated and sugary drinks during a fast, including the artificial sweeteners found in diet drinks.
- 3. It is important after a fast to control your cravings and avoid overeating, which can nullify the gains made during the fast.

Commit to staying the course -to fast from the beginning to the end. You are well able to do it, and God's grace is sufficient for you.



WEEK 1
WALKING IN RIGHTEOUSNESS



A CALL TO FAST

So the people of Nineveh believed God, proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest to the least of them. Then word came to the king of Nineveh; and he arose from his throne and laid aside his robe, covered himself with sackcloth and sat in ashes. (Jonah 3:5-6)

Morning Reflection Jonah 3:5-10

So the people of Nineveh believed God, proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest to the least of them. Then word came to the king of Nineveh; and he arose from his throne and laid aside his robe, covered himself with sackcloth and sat in ashes. And he caused it to be proclaimed and published throughout Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste anything; do not let them eat, or drink water. But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily to God; yes, let everyone turn from his evil way and from the violence that is in his hands. Who can tell if God will turn and relent, and turn away from His fierce anger, so that we may not perish? Then God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God relented from the disaster that He had said He would bring upon them, and He did not do it.

Consecration

- 1. Bless the Lord for the grace to begin this year's 40 Days of Power; thank Him for this sacred time of consecration.
- 2. Confess your sins before God and ask for His empowering grace to walk in righteousness and resist temptation.
- 3. Surrender your entire being—spirit, soul, and body—to the Lord; ask Him to draw you into wholehearted devotion.
- 4. Pray that your family will hunger after God during this season; pray that they will turn to Him with sincere hearts.

- 5. Ask the Lord to help you overcome every distraction that competes with your focus on Him during this fast.
- 6. Pray for spiritual sensitivity to hear God's voice clearly through His Word each day.
- 7. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you step by step into God's purpose and perfect will for your life.
- 8. Pray that your example will inspire your family to walk closely with the Lord and seek His guidance.

- 9. Give thanks to God for His faithful protection that surrounds you and your household like a mighty shield.
- 10. Cover your life, family, church, and nation with the blood of Jesus; declare that by the power in His blood, you, your family the church and nation is protected from every attack of the enemy.
- 11. Pray against every temptation that seeks to draw you away from God's presence.
- 12. Declare that as you dwell in the secret place of the Most High, no harm shall overcome you or your loved ones.

Declaration

Today, I lift my spirit, soul, and body to the Lord and commit to pursue Him with undivided devotion. The Holy Spirit leads me in righteousness, so I will not stray. I belong to Christ, and in Him, I dwell securely, shielded by His grace and guided by His truth, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Praise God that **Albania** remains open to the Gospel; ask Him to raise up faithful partners to help evangelize the nation.
- 14. Intercede for **Algeria**; ask the Lord to send laborers who will plant churches and disciple believers.
- 15. Pray that **Angola** will reap spiritual fruit from the seeds of the gospel that has been sown in the land; ask God to raise it as a testimony of His mercy.
- 16. Cry out for revival in **Antigua** and **Barbuda**, that the hearts of believers there will be stirred to seek the Lord with passion.

- 17. Thank God that His presence goes with you into your workplace; thank Him that you are equipped with divine insight and favor.
- 18. Ask the Lord to make your work a platform for spiritual growth and a testimony of His goodness.
- 19. Pray that your integrity and faith at work will lead others to hunger for God.
- 20. Ask for God's blessing over your professional life, that your efforts will prosper as you honour Him with diligence.

Iesus

- 21. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill your heart and mind with fresh desire to know Jesus; pray that every spiritual dullness will be broken.
- 22. Ask for a deeper revelation of Christ as you read the Word and spend time in prayer.
- 23. Pray for grace and discipline to seek Christ daily and resist complacency and spiritual lukewarmness.
- 24. Present your unsaved family members to the Lord; pray that the light of Christ will shine in their hearts and draw them to the Lord.

Declaration

As Christ is lifted high among the nations, His healing and salvation will reach every land. In my work life, the hand of the Lord brings favor and draws me closer to Him. His truth lights my path, and His presence sets my heart on fire for His work, in Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection Jeremiah 18:7-8

The instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, to pull down, and to destroy it, if that nation against whom I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it.

Declaration

I humble myself before the throne of God and pledge to seek Him above all else. By His Spirit and through His Word, I am led into righteousness and I find peace that surpasses understanding. My fast is unto the Lord, and in Him, I am established, in Jesus' name. Amen.



UNITED WITH CHRIST

Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection. (Romans 6:4-5)

Morning Reflection Romans 6:1-7

What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin.

Consecration

- Exalt Jesus for exchanging your shame for His righteousness and making you a new creation in Him.
- 2. Ask the Lord to wash and cleanse you and fill you with a spirit that delights in His will.
- 3. Intercede for your family members—that the Holy Spirit will convict their hearts and turn them to a life of holiness.
- 4. Pray that the church of Christ will be purified and awakened to eagerly anticipate His glorious return.

- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to sharpen the ears of your heart so you can recognize His voice above all others.
- 6. Pray for strength and grace to honor God with your body and live as a vessel set apart for Him.
- 7. Intercede for the Church to boldly proclaim a call to repentance and a return to godly living across the nations.
- 8. Ask the Lord to draw unbelievers into His family and guide them on the path of righteousness during this season of prayer.

- 9. Thank God for being your rock through every trial and for shielding you from destruction.
- 10. Confess that as you walk in obedience and holiness, divine protection is your portion.
- 11. Declare that the blood of Jesus has washed you clean and silenced every accusation of the enemy.
- 12. Pray against every unholy practice in the Church that seeks to tarnish its witness and dishonor the name of Christ.

Declaration

Lord Jesus, thank You for calling me out of darkness into Your marvelous light. I lay aside every garment of sin and walk in Your righteousness. As a child of God, I stand secure and covered under the banner of Christ and walk boldly in holiness, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray that the hearts of believers in **Argentina** will burn with a desire to spread the Good News.
- 14. Call on the Lord to release His peace upon **Armenia** and bring healing to its land and people.
- 15. Pray that the Gospel will flourish among all communities in **Aruba**, including immigrant groups, bringing transformation and unity across the island.
- 16. Cry out for a mighty move of the Spirit in **Australia**, reviving the Church and restoring their first love for Jesus.
- 17. Ask the Lord to raise up fearless believers in **Austria** who will pursue holiness and proclaim Christ boldly.

- 18. Give thanks to God for enabling you to reflect His holiness and glory in your profession.
- 19. Speak life over your career, declaring that you will advance in your career pursuits under God's divine favor.
- 20. Affirm that you walk above worldly limitations because the Lord is your Helper and Strength.
- 21. Ask God to open doors and grant favor to fellow believers who are living uprightly and serving Him faithfully.

Jesus

- 22. Pray that the Lord will open your understanding of what it truly means to walk in holiness before a holy God.
- 23. Ask for divine help to live a sanctified life and declare that you are set apart for greater works in Christ.
- 24. Lift your family before God and pray for a renewed passion and hunger for godly living.
- 25. Give thanks that God has called you His own and has set you apart as a treasured vessel for His glory.

Declaration

Let the nations lift their gates and let the King of Glory come in; let His name be honoured across the earth. In my life and work, may His righteousness be seen. I am a vessel set apart; I reflect the holiness of Christ wherever I go, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Declaration

I rejoice in the grace that has made me holy and set me apart in Christ. I have been united with Him in His death and now walk in newness of life. I am God's treasured possession; I walk in victory over sin, and receive my inheritance among the saints, in Jesus' name. Amen.



TURN TO RIGHTEOUSNESS

That you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness. (Ephesians 4:22-24)

Morning Reflection Ephesians 4:17-24

This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But you have not so learned Christ, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

Consecration

- Set yourself apart unto the Lord and ask Him to empower you to live a life wholly
 devoted to Him.
- 2. Surrender every area of your life to God and pray for a renewed passion to pursue holiness with conviction.
- Declare that during these 40 Days of Power, you will walk in the awareness of God's presence daily.
- 4. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to live by His power and not by the impulses of the flesh.

- 5. Invite the Holy Spirit to guide your heart into a lifestyle of purity and to help you avoid every form of compromise.
- Ask God to train your ears to hear His voice and give you a heart that responds quickly in obedience.
- 7. Pull down every stronghold of distraction and ungodly desire that hinders your full submission to God.
- 8. Commit every decision into the hands of the Lord and trust Him to lead you on paths of righteousness.

- 9. Ask God to guard you from choices that appear good but lead away from His perfect will.
- Declare that because Christ lives in you, every weapon of the enemy against your life shall fail.
- 11. Ask God to uncover and cancel every hidden trap or plot of the enemy concerning you and your family.
- 12. Pray for divine protection from harmful relationships and habits that can derail your walk with the Lord.

Declaration

I declare that I have put off the old self and embraced the new life in Christ. I no longer live for sin, but Christ lives in me. I am set apart for God's holy purpose, and each step I take is led by His Spirit. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray for courage and wisdom for believers in **Azerbaijan**, that the Gospel will quietly but powerfully impact hearts even under religious restrictions.
- 14. Pray for increased resources, favor, and fruitfulness in missions in the **Bahamas**; declare a great harvest of souls.
- 15. Ask the Lord to strengthen the underground church in **Bahrain** and to reveal Christ through love, testimony, and transformed lives.
- 16. Ask for boldness and divine strength for believers in **Bangladesh** as they witness in the face of pressure and opposition.
- 17. Rebuke every resistance that hinders soul-winning in **Barbados** and declare open heavens over the nation.

- 18. Ask the Lord to make you a visible expression of Christ's love, truth, and excellence in your workplace.
- 19. Pray for the release of every resource needed to thrive in your career.
- 20. Claim God's promise to restore lost time, missed opportunities, and unfulfilled potential in your professional journey.
- 21. Ask for divine insight to make decisions that protect the fruit of your labor and position you for advancement.

Jesus

- 22. Ask God to help you live daily in the awareness that your life is under the lordship of Jesus Christ.
- 23. Declare that in this season, you are God's vessel—revealing His wisdom and character to those around you.
- 24. Intercede for your family to encounter the Holy Spirit in a life-changing way; declare that your home belongs to the Lord.
- 25. Ask the Lord for supernatural encounters during this season that will deepen your intimacy with Christ and strengthen your walk with Him.

Declaration

I declare that the nations are turning to righteousness as the Spirit of God convicts hearts and draws people to repentance. As I imitate Christ and live for Him, others are touched by my example and inspired to follow Him. I praise the Lord for making me a vessel of honour, set apart for His glorious purpose. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Colossians 3:9-10

Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.

Declaration

I praise the Lord that my life is hidden in Christ and clothed in His righteousness. By faith, I walk in daily victory over sin. I choose a consecrated life that brings honour and glory to God's holy name, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**



LIVE BY THE SPIRIT

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. (Galatians 5:16-17)

Morning Reflection Galatians 5:16-25

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Consecration

- 1. Praise the Lord for the gift of the Holy Spirit; thank Him that He empowers you to walk in victory over sin.
- 2. Declare your freedom in Christ from every sinful habit that has held you bound.
- Ask the Lord to create in you a deep desire to live by the Spirit and a genuine longing for holiness.
- 4. Pray that your spirit will stay sensitive and submissive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit daily.

- 5. Pray for clarity and sensitivity to follow the leadings of the Holy Spirit in all areas of your life.
- Ask the Lord to renew your mind and help you to align your desires with His will and Word.
- 7. Intercede for your household—that each member will seek and walk in God's perfect will.
- 8. Pray for divine wisdom to resist pressures that push you into decisions outside of God's purpose.

- 9. Declare that as you walk in the Spirit, no weapon fashioned against you will prosper.
- 10. Reject every influence, voice, or habit that competes with God's counsel in your life.
- 11. Thank the Lord that His Spirit will guard your heart and lead you into all truth.
- 12. Ask the Lord to preserve you from environments, conversations, and people that weaken your faith.

Declaration

Thank You Lord, for Your word that instructs and corrects. I declare that I am committed to obeying Your voice. You are my Shepherd; I will follow You into paths of peace and righteousness. As I yield to Your leading, my soul will find rest in You, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray for a spiritual awakening in **Belarus** amid political and social unrest, and ask God to strengthen the small but faithful body of believers.
- 14. Break the power of deception that blinds hearts in **Belgium**; pray for the light of the Gospel to shine brightly.
- 15. Pray for divine protection, strength, and fruitfulness for missionaries labouring in **Belize**.
- 16. Uproot ungodly cultural practices in **Benin** that oppose the Gospel and keep people in spiritual bondage.
- 17. Intercede for believers in **Bhutan**; ask God to strengthen them to stand firm under oppressive spiritual influences.

- 18. Place your career journey before the Lord; ask for alignment with His timing, plans, and promotions.
- 19. Pray for integrity and boldness to make godly choices in the workplace even when it is unpopular.
- 20. Commit your business plans and innovations to God; ask Him to breathe life and success upon them.
- 21. Ask God to raise Christian entrepreneurs and professionals whose excellence will glorify Christ and influence others.

Jesus

- 22. Ask the Holy Spirit to open your spiritual eyes to know Jesus more deeply and intimately.
- 23. Pray that your relationship with Jesus will grow beyond religion into personal communion and daily obedience.
- 24. Ask God for the grace to remain steadfast and obedient to Christ in all seasons.
- 25. Declare that as you follow Jesus wholeheartedly, His light will shine through you and draw others to Him.

Declaration

I believe in the power of God working in me to fulfill His purpose. I receive divine wisdom to mature in my calling and to be a vessel of blessing to my family and the nations. My life will reflect the nature and character of Christ wherever I go, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Romans 8:13-14

For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Declaration

Through Christ's finished work, I receive strength to do God's will. Like the sons of Issachar, I walk in spiritual discernment and obey divine instruction. God's Word lights my path, and by His guidance, I fulfill my purpose in Jesus' name. Amen.



WEEK 2
IMMANUEL — GOD WITH US



THE FAITHFULNESS OF GOD'S PROMISES

But as God is faithful, our word to you was not Yes and No. For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us—by me, Silvanus, and Timothy—was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes. For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. (2 Corinthians 1:18-20)

Morning Reflection 2 Corinthians 1:15-23

And in this confidence I intended to come to you before, that you might have a second benefit— to pass by way of you to Macedonia, to come again from Macedonia to you, and be helped by you on my way to Judea. Therefore, when I was planning this, did I do it lightly? Or the things I plan, do I plan according to the flesh, that with me there should be Yes, Yes, and No, No? But as God is faithful, our word to you was not Yes and No. For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us—by me, Silvanus, and Timothy—was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes. For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee. Moreover I call God as witness against my soul, that to spare you I came no more to Corinth. Not that we have dominion over your faith, but are fellow workers for your joy; for by faith you stand.

Consecration

- 1. Thank the Lord for the privilege of drawing near through the blood of Jesus, and for the assurance that He hears when you call.
- 2. Ask for the cleansing power of Christ to purge every thought or attitude that hinders your intimacy with God.
- 3. Declare that in moments of pressure, you will remain anchored in the victory that Christ secured for you and in His faithful promises.
- 4. Affirm that as you seek the Lord in these 40 Days of Power, He will lead you into all truth and victory.

- 5. Pray that the Lord will sharpen your ears to discern His voice amid life's distractions.
- 6. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to the promise of God you need for every season.
- 7. Ask for divine guidance in every decision you make; affirm that no confusion or loss will be your portion.
- 8. Pray that God will surround you with wise and godly counsel, that through them, you will experience His timely help in all matters.

- 9. Thank God for His unfailing love and covering over your household; declare that in Him, you are more than a conqueror.
- 10. Pray cancelling every evil plan of the enemy and ask the Lord to expose hidden traps laid for you by him.
- 11. Pray that no weapon formed against the Church will prosper, and that her influence will increase.
- 12. Declare that you, your family, and your church are shielded by divine grace and preserved from every harm.

Declaration

I give thanks to God who has drawn me near by the blood of Jesus and made me a partaker of His promises. I walk in Christ's victory and led daily by Him Spirit. In all my choices, I am guided by the Lord, and no purpose of God for my life shall fail to materialize, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 14. Intercede for the Church in **Botswana**, that the Church will receive divine strategies to engage young people meaningfully, raising a generation rooted in truth, holiness, and purpose.
- 15. Thank God for the vibrant evangelical movement in **Brazil**. Pray that as church leaders inquire of the Lord, they will prioritize discipleship, integrity, and social impact over popularity and materialism.
- 16. Lift up believers in **Brunei**. Pray that as they seek the Lord, He will guide them with wisdom and courage to live out their faith powerfully, and that the underground Church will flourish in unity and spiritual strength.
- 17. Intercede for missionaries and the Christian community in **Bulgaria**. Pray that as they seek God's direction, they will be equipped to share the gospel effectively, and reawaken a hunger for Christ across the nation.

- 18. Ask God for wisdom and insight to create innovative solutions that will distinguish your work.
- 19. Pray for divine favour with supervisors and gatekeepers; declare recognition and elevation in your sphere.
- 20. Ask the Lord to guard your heart against jealousy, distraction, and unhealthy competition at work.
- 21. Claim full restoration of missed or lost opportunities in your job, business, or career during this season.

Jesus

- 22. Declare that no hardship will shake your confidence in God's ability; declare that you will remain firm because He is with you.
- 23. Ask the Good Shepherd to lead you beside still waters and cause your soul to rest in His promises.
- 24. Pray that God will redirect your steps from paths of self-will to the ways He has ordained for your good.
- 25. Surrender every difficult issue in your life to the Lord and ask Him to take full control.

Declaration

Scripture for Reflection Romans 4:16-22

Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all (as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, "So shall your descendants be." And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore "it was accounted to him for righteousness."

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life—the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us—that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.

Consecration

- Thank the Lord for being the eternal Word who became flesh and fulfilled His covenant to dwell with us.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to make your heart tender to His leading and draw you into complete surrender to His will.
- 3. Pray for grace to walk in constant humility, fully depending on Christ alone.
- 4. Thank God that the life of Christ is in you and making you more like Christ.

- 5. Pray that by the Spirit's guidance you will grow in wisdom, stature, and favor with God and people.
- 6. Ask for the Lord's divine peace as you take decisions that will glorify His name.
- 7. Pray that your faith will remain steadfast through tests and trials as you stand firm on the word of faith.
- 8. Commit the Church into God's hands—ask Him to guide leaders and believers alike to fulfil every divine purpose concerning His house.

Morning Reflection Acts 17:22-34

Then Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus and said, "Men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are very religious; for as I was passing through and considering the objects of your worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Therefore, the One whom you worship without knowing, Him I proclaim to you: God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things. And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.' Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man's devising. Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent, because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead." And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked, while others said, "We will hear you again on this matter." So Paul departed from among them. However, some men joined him and believed, among them Dionysius the Areopagite, a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

Consecration

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Consecration

- 1. Praise God that He is for you and that He has given you all things that pertain to life and godliness.
- 2. Humbly confess any unrepented sin and receive the Lord's mercy and cleansing.
- 3. Pray that the Holy Spirit will unveil the nature of Christ to you in the Word; ask for grace to walk in His example.

- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit to purify your heart from fear, anxiety, and internal conflict as you seek God in this season of consecration.
- 4. Pray that God's Word will richly dwell in you, equipping you to master your thoughts, appetites, and emotions in righteousness.

- 5. Thank God for the clarity and direction He provides through His Word, which lights your path and reveals His will.
- 6. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you continually into all truth and keep you aligned with God's purpose each day.

And the keeper of the prison, awaking from sleep and seeing the prison doors open, supposing the prisoners had fled, drew his sword and was about to kill himself. But Paul called with a loud voice, saying, "Do yourself no harm, for we are all here." Then he called for a light, ran in, and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household." Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their stripes. And immediately he and all his family were baptized. Now when he had brought them into his house, he set food before them; and he rejoiced, having believed in God with all his household.

Consecration

- 1. Present your life afresh to the Lord as a living sacrifice and ask for grace to prioritize His Word above personal ambition and comfort.
- 2. Pray for a sensitive heart that discerns the leading of the Holy Spirit and boldly follows His prompting in every circumstance.
- 3. Dedicate your household to the Lord; declare that His Word will govern every decision and action in your family.
- 4. Ask God to shield you and your loved ones from ungodly influences and counsel that would derail your walk with Him.

- 5. Celebrate God's presence through every season of your life; thank Him for being your ever-present help.
- 6. Ask the Holy Spirit to align your desires with the things that please God and not the fleeting desires of the world.
- 7. Pray for divine connections—godly mentors and companions who will inspire and counsel you toward your destiny.
- 8. Praise God for His grace that upholds you, even in your weakest moments; thank Him for never letting go of you.

- 9. Thank God for shielding you from the traps of the enemy and preserving you from harm.
- 10. Declare that limitations of all kinds against your family are broken now.

Jesus

- 21. Thank God for His wise counsel through His word and the godly people He has surrounded you with.
- 22. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you to worship and praise the Lord in spirit and in truth.
- 23. Pray that the doors of your home will be open to Jesus for Him to dwell in.
- 24. Declare the liberty of Christ over every negative condition affecting you and your family.

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.

Declaration

THE HOPE OF GLORY

To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. (Colossians 1:27)

Morning Reflection Colossians 1:24-29

I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church, of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to fulfill the word of God, the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.

Consecration

- 1. Surrender your ways to the Lord and ask Him to lead you deeper into His presence during this sacred season.
- 2. Pray for a renewed and transformed mind that trusts in the wisdom of God's Word above all else.
- 3. Consecrate your life afresh to the Lord throughout these 40 days; ask Him to kindle a deeper desire to serve Him wholeheartedly.
- 4. Request divine grace to remain steadfast in obedience and to hold firmly to the truth of His Word in all seasons.

- 5. Give thanks to the Lord for going ahead of you; declare that His hand will lead you in all your undertakings.
- 6. Pray that the eyes of your heart will be enlightened to understand God's good and perfect plans for your life.
- 7. Ask for wisdom and the courage to resist decisions driven by the flesh.
- 8. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to share the message of the glory of Christ to someone who needs it.

- 9. Ask the Lord for spiritual discernment to navigate and conquer recurring battles that challenge your progress.
- 10. Declare that no seed of the enemy shall survive in you because Jesus lives in you.
- 11. Pray for angelic intervention and continual protection over your household day and night.
- 12. Declare that the glory of the Lord will wipe away any form of shame in your life and family.

Declaration

Father, I thank You for bringing me into Your presence today. I proclaim Your authority, wisdom, and protection over my life and family. My steps are ordered, my heart is aligned, and my soul is anchored in You. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- Ask God to preserve and strengthen believers in **Dominica** and stir the unsaved to embrace Christ.
- 14. Pray for the church in the **Dominican Republic** to gain divine influence in leadership, transforming the nation through the Gospel.
- 15. Cover the church in **Ecuador** with God's glory and grace, declaring supernatural increase and divine protection.
- 16. Ask God to strengthen the Church in **Egypt** with courage and wisdom, and to protect believers as they witness amidst tight religious restrictions and social pressure.
- 17. Pray for a spiritual awakening in **El Salvador**—declare that crime and social decay will give way to righteousness and peace.

- 18. Ask the Lord to give you strategic insight to create solutions, services, and products that elevate your impact in your field.
- 19. Pray for supernatural favour before supervisors, clients, and partners; declare that your excellence will be rewarded.
- 20. Pray that God's glory will fill your career and workplace, setting you among the best.
- 21. Intercede on behalf of the unemployed in your family and ask Christ to strengthen their hope for a career breakthrough.

Iesus

- 22. Declare that regardless of affliction or trials, you will remain steadfast in faith, knowing that Christ in you is the Hope of Glory.
- 23. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you the riches of the glory you have in Jesus.
- 24. Pray for grace to live not for self-glory but for the glory of Jesus alone.
- 25. Bring before God every area of doubt or unbelief, and declare that hope will rise and fear will flee in Jesus' name.

Declaration

With Christ in me as my hope of glory; I shall not be ashamed. He directs the work of my hands and blesses all my labour. I declare that His presence goes before me. In this Jesus year, I will testify of His faithfulness and see His glory in every area of my life. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Ephesians 3:14-21

For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Declaration

I am filled with all the fullness of God as I grow in my knowledge of the love of Christ. The Holy Spirit leads me into divine encounters with God's glory. I go from strength to strength and from glory to glory as I trust in Christ. In Jesus' name **Amen**.

TAKE UP YOUR CROSS

Then He said to them all, 'If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.' (Luke 9:23)

Morning Reflection Luke 9:23-27

Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels. But I tell you truly, there are some standing here who shall not taste death till they see the kingdom of God."

Consecration

- Bless the Lord for His sustaining grace that enables you to walk uprightly and live blameless before Him.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to purify your heart and renew your mind, cleansing every thought and desire that draws you away from God's presence.
- 3. Commit your path to the Lord, asking for a spirit of humility and wisdom to walk in integrity and purity before Him.
- 4. Pray that in this season of consecration and prayer, your affections will be realigned to long more deeply for Christ above all else.

- 5. Surrender your goals, dreams, and expectations to God; pray for grace to honour Him in every accomplishment.
- 6. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you at every turning point and align you with God's will.
- 7. Petition the Lord to keep your feet from evil and to make your paths straight.
- 8. Pray for divine strength to reject every practise that encourages compromise or rebellion against God's commands.

- 9. Give thanks to the Lord for His deliverance from danger and death.
- 10. Declare boldly that every affliction that has troubled your peace is ending by God's power, in Jesus' name.
- 11. Call upon the Lord to fight for you and give you victory over every barrier and resistance.
- 12. By faith, silence every false accusation and evil report spoken over your life.

Declaration

I declare that I am set apart to do the will of my Father. As I follow Christ daily, He establishes the work of my hands and upholds me with His righteous right hand. The Lord is my covering, my refuge, and the lifter of my head. In Jesus' name, **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray that the hearts of believers in **Equatorial Guinea** may remain loyal to Christ alone and not be turned to idolatry or compromise.

- 20. Speak over your work and declare that regardless of economic uncertainty, you shall experience promotion and provision.
- 21. Release a blessing over your business, job, or ministry—declaring growth, multiplication, and influence that brings glory to God.

Jesus

- 22. Pray for a fresh understanding of the cross of Christ that will increase your faith to serve Him more.
- 23. Ask the Lord for testimonies that will glorify Him and cause others to put their trust in Him.
- 24. Declare that this Jesus-year shall be marked by divine surprises, new territories, and undeniable progress in every area of your life.
- 25. Pray for the grace to imitate Jesus by daily taking up your cross and following Him.

Declaration

I decree that I am seated with Christ in heavenly places, far above all rule and power. The Lord has set my feet in a spacious place, and this season shall yield abundance and overflow. I walk in supernatural grace and victory, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Matthew 10:37-39

He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.

Declaration

The Lord is faithful to those who seek Him and walk in purity of heart. As I take up my cross daily and follow Jesus, the Lord will cause my boundaries to fall in pleasant places. I will testify of His goodness in the land of the living. In Jesus' name, Amen.



FORSAKING ALL

So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.' (Luke 9:23)

Morning Reflection Luke 5:1-11

So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net." And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men." So when they had brought their boats to land, they for sook all and followed Him.

Consecration

- 1. Thank God for drawing you closer to Himself in this season of prayer and fasting.
- 2. Offer yourself as a living sacrifice, consecrated for communion with the Lord.
- 3. Ask God for grace to let go of anything that stands between you and His presence.
- Declare your commitment to seek the Lord in prayer and devotion throughout this season and beyond.

- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you the things in your life which you need to forsake.
- 6. Ask the Lord to speak clearly to you in times of prayer, and for grace to listen with discernment.
- 7. Ask God to quicken your spirit to respond in obedience whenever He prompts you to pray.
- 8. Pray that the Church will forsake man-made ambitions to pursue God-given purposes.

- Rebuke every voice of guilt, shame, or condemnation that seeks to draw you away from God's presence.
- 10. Ask the Lord to break the power of idleness, slothfulness, and spiritual complacency from your life and household.
- 11. Pray against every scheme of the enemy designed to dull your spiritual hunger.
- 12. Declare that you and your family are preserved as you dwell continually under the shadow of the Almighty.

Declaration

Father, I bless You for this season of consecration. I declare that nothing shall hinder me from Your presence. Your presence is my delight and dwelling place. I will seek You daily and be renewed, empowered, and transformed, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray for a powerful move of God's Spirit to stir a revival of prayer throughout the nation of **Finland**.
- 14. Ask the Lord to open the heavens over **France**, pouring out His Spirit to awaken hearts to the gospel.
- 15. Pray that God will raise dedicated intercessors over the Church in Gabon.
- 16. Intercede for the Church in **Gambia**, asking God to grant them the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to know Him deeply.
- 17. Pray that the Church in **Georgia** will be strengthened to stand for truth amid cultural changes, and that believers will shine brightly with wisdom, purity, and spiritual boldness.

- 18. Pray for divine inspiration and new insight concerning your career and calling.
- Declare that every challenge in your professional life will be overturned by God's mighty hand.
- 20. Confess that the anointing to create wealth and prosper is upon you through Christ.
- 21. Pray that your work will not become an idol that takes the place of Christ in your life.

Iesus

- 22. Pray that your eyes and heart will be fixed on Jesus in this season of prayer.
- 23. Ask God for a deeper revelation of who Christ is and the grace to follow Him alone.
- 24. Proclaim that as you follow the Lord, you will be changed into His image and glory.
- 25. Ask the Lord to convict the unsaved in your family so they will come to follow Jesus.

Declaration

I acknowledge the Lord as sovereign over my life and over the nations. I declare a mighty revival of prayer and holiness is breaking forth across the world. Many will turn to the Lord and grow in the knowledge of Him. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Philippians 3:7-9

But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith.

Declaration

I will abide in the secret place of the Most High all the days of my life. I will seek the Lord, and His word shall be my deepest longing. In His presence, I will be taught, empowered, and transformed. In Jesus' name, **Amen.**



HE LEADS THE WAY

And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. (John 10:4)

Morning Reflection Iohn 10:1-6

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." Jesus used this illustration, but they did not understand the things which He spoke to them.

Consecration

- Confess before the Lord every known and unknown sin; thank Him for the cleansing power of His blood.
- 2. In the name of Jesus, pull down every stronghold of thought and imagination that has kept you bound in sin and disobedience.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit for strength to walk away from any relationship, environment, or practice that leads you away from God's holiness.
- 4. Declare that you and your household shall serve the Lord with reverence and faithfulness all the days of your lives.

- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to unveil the will of God for your life as you walk in surrender and obedience to His leading.

- 25. Declare that throughout these 40 Days of Power, you are being shaped more and more into the image and likeness of Christ.

Declaration

Scripture for Reflection Psalm 23:1-4

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

Declaration

I will seek the Lord with all my heart. As I consecrate my life and my household to Him, we are preserved from every destruction and guided into the fullness of God's purposes for our lives. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**



THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. (Luke 14:27)

Morning Reflection Luke 14:25-33

Now great multitudes went with Him. And He turned and said to them, "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it—lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, saying, "This man began to build and was not able to finish'? Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace. So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.

Consecration

- 1. Ask the Lord to make you into a righteous dwelling place for His Spirit.
- 2. Pray that God will turn your heart from anything that doesn't please Him.
- 3. Commit every area of your life to God and confess that all you have belongs to Him.
- 4. Ask for a heart that discerns His will and embraces it with joy, even when it requires personal sacrifice or loss.

- 5. Ask God to fill you with wisdom to face every challenge that comes with walking closely with Christ.
- 6. Pray for grace to overcome every barrier that seeks to limit your obedience and growth.
- 7. Ask the Lord to guard your heart from doubt and unbelief and help you to cling to His Word as your sure foundation.
- 8. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you how to become a true disciple of Jesus.

- 9. Ask the Lord to keep you from backsliding as you forsake all to follow Him.
- 10. Plead the blood of Jesus as a covering from every evil assignment against your life.
- 11. By the authority of the Word, declare your victory over every attack meant to harm you.
- 12. Pray for spiritual strength and clarity, that you may resist discouragement and be revived daily through God's Word.

- 14. Ask God to raise spiritually mature and courageous Christian leaders in **Guinea-Bissau** who will strengthen the Church and influence society.
- 15. Pray that the gospel will penetrate every sphere of society in **Guyana**, bringing moral and spiritual transformation.
- 16. Pray that strongholds of voodoo and false religion will be broken in **Haiti** as the light of Christ shines on the land.
- 17. Ask the Lord to intervene in **Honduras** through miracles and bold witnesses as the gospel spreads and many are drawn to Christ.

- 18. Pray for grace to be a faithful steward of the abilities God has given you and to use them for His glory.
- 19. Ask the Lord to make you an exemplary disciple of Jesus in your workplace.
- 20. Surrender your projects to the Lord, asking for discernment and open doors in your work and career.
- 21. Declare that you will accomplish great exploits through God's empowerment and that your labour will be fruitful and lasting.

Jesus

- 22. Ask the Lord for grace to surrender fully to His Lordship, embracing the cross and following Him daily regardless of the cost.
- 23. Declare that the value of knowing Christ far surpasses anything you must lay down or walk away from in this life.
- 24. Ask Jesus to deepen your hunger for His presence, your commitment to His mission, and your willingness to be conformed to His sufferings.
- 25. Declare that you are pressing toward the upward call in Christ Jesus—forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward in obedience.

Declaration

Scripture for Reflection Matthew 13:44-46

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it."

Declaration

I thank God for His Word that renews and strengthens me. I can do all things through Christ who empowers me by His Spirit and truth. As I follow Jesus and bear my cross, I walk in alignment with His purpose and I shall not be ashamed, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**



FIXING OUR EYES ON JESUS

Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2)

Morning Reflection Hebrews 12:1-11

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls. You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin. And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; For whom the Lord loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives." If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness. Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

Consecration

- 1. Thank the Lord for His mercies and for sustaining you through this journey of devotion and power.
- 2. Pray for a heart that is continually softened before God—willing to yield and obey at His prompting.
- Ask the Lord to purge every distraction and idol that competes with His place in your heart and life.
- 4. Declare that your eyes, your heart, and your mind are set on Christ; ask for grace to live a life wholly devoted to Him.

Guidance

- 5. Present every plan and decision before the Lord; ask Him to direct your path with clarity and peace.
- 6. Pray for discernment to recognize His leading above all the voices that contend for your attention.
- 7. Ask the Holy Spirit to align your desires with God's will so that your steps are always ordered by Him.
- 8. Thank the Lord that even in seasons of uncertainty, His guidance is sure and His counsel unfailing.

Protection

- Ask the Lord to shield you from the subtle snares that seek to turn your gaze away from Jesus.
- Declare that no fear, temptation, or trial will separate you from the love and purpose of God.
- 11. Pray that every storm meant to shake your faith will instead deepen your trust in the Lord.
- 12. Affirm that your life and household are hidden in Christ and preserved from harm, distraction, and deception.

Declaration

I fix my heart on the Lord who is my portion and my strength. His light shines upon my path, His hand holds me fast, and His voice leads me into truth. I will not be shaken, for my eyes are set on Him, and He is faithful to complete what He has begun in me. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Intercede for the spiritual awakening of the nation of Hungary; ask God to raise bold witnesses and faithful churches.
- 14. Pray that in Iceland, the hearts of many will be stirred toward the knowledge of God and revival will break forth.
- 15. Ask the Lord to send His Word with power across India, transforming the land for Christ.
- 16. Declare that in Indonesia, the gospel shall be boldly proclaimed, and many shall turn to the Lord.

Work and Career

- 17. Submit your work, career path, and goals to the Lord; ask Him to establish your career.
- 18. Pray for a spirit of faithfulness and integrity to rest upon your workplace.
- 19. Ask for divine wisdom to rise above workplace challenges, and for open doors that only God can create.
- 20. Declare that your work will be fruitful, your efforts meaningful, and your legacy Christ-honouring.

Iesus

- 21. Offer praise to Jesus for being the One who began your faith and is perfecting it daily through every trial and triumph.
- 22. Ask for grace to keep your focus on Christ even when the journey becomes difficult.
- 23. Pray that as you look unto Jesus, you will be transformed into His likeness.
- 24. Declare that Jesus is your daily bread, your eternal reward, and that no earthly pursuit compares to knowing Him.

Declaration

My eyes are fixed on Jesus, my Lord and Redeemer. In Him I live, move, and have my being. Through Him, nations shall be saved, my work shall prosper, and my soul shall be satisfied. I live each day with purpose and power because I follow the One who leads me in triumph. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection Psalm 123:1-2

Unto You I lift up my eyes, O You who dwell in the heavens. Behold, as the eyes of servants look to the hand of their masters, as the eyes of a maid to the hand of her mistress, So our eyes look to the Lord our God, until He has mercy on us.

Declaration

I set my heart and focus on Christ. I run with endurance the race set before me, laying aside every weight. I press on, not looking back, for my eyes are on the One who reigns forever. In Him, I find strength, direction, and eternal joy. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**



FOLLOW HIS STEPS

For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps.

(1 Peter 2:21)

Morning Reflection 1 Peter 2:18-25

Servants, be submissive to your masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh. For this is commendable, if because of conscience toward God one endures grief, suffering wrongfully. For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God. For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: "Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth"; who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

Consecration

- 1. Praise God for the transformative power of your new birth in Christ; thank Him that you are able to overcome the world through faith.
- 2. Dedicate yourself anew to the Lord and boldly declare victory over past sins.
- 3. Ask God to grant you discernment to refute doubts and deceptions that weaken your faith in Jesus Christ as the Son of God.
- 4. Ask the Lord for renewed grace and faith to continue living as an overcomer in every aspect of your life.

- 5. Bless the Lord for restoring you to Himself when you go astray.
- 6. Ask for the Holy Spirit's discernment to walk the path of righteousness.
- 7. Ask the Lord to show you an example of the righteous life He wants you to live.
- 8. Intercede for loved ones who have strayed from Christ; ask the Lord to bring them back to the faith.

- 9. Thank the Lord for His constant protection and deliverance from the snares of the world.
- 10. Commit the peace and sanity of your home into God's hands and confess that your home will not be broken by the adversary.
- 11. Resist every oppression of the enemy fighting your family's progress.
- 12. Declare by faith that you overcome the enemy by the blood of the Lamb and the power of your testimony.

Declaration

In Christ, I am empowered to overcome sinfulness and ungodliness. My home is sanctified unto the Lord. By the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony, I walk in victory in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

- 13. Thank God for revealing Himself to the people of **Iran** amidst challenges; pray for the flourishing of the underground church; pray that peace will prevail in every war situation.
- 14. Pray for the salvation of the **Iraqi** people; that they will seek Christ in the midst of social instability.
- 15. Pray for a revival in **Ireland**; ask that the young generation will turn to the Lord.
- 16. Pray for hearts to turn to God in **Israel** and for adherents of Judaism to experience true salvation in Christ; pray that there will be rest in the land from all conflict.

Work and Career

- 17. Praise God that you will experience His blessings in your career this Jesus year.
- 18. Present your career challenges to the Lord; pray for wisdom to overcome them all.
- 19. Ask for divine partnerships that will help propel you to the next level in your business and career.
- 20. Ask God to bring an end to evil works in your community and replace them with godly ones that promote business and work.

Jesus

- 21. Praise God for His abundant grace which is sufficient to help you in times of need.
- 22. Boldly declare that you are healed by the strips of Jesus.
- 23. Pray that as you follow the steps of Jesus, you will grow in your knowledge of Him.
- 24. Ask the Lord to use you to influence your family to follow in the steps of Jesus.

Declaration

Through God's grace, nations will come to Him. Through wisdom and diligence, I will overcome challenges and difficulties and become what God has purposed for me in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection John 13:12–17

So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?" "You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am." "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet." "For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you." "Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him." "If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them."

Declaration

Christ's transforming power is at work in me. I have sufficient grace to follow in the steps of Jesus. My life will bring glory to my Lord and my God in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.' (Philippians 1:21)

Morning Reflection Philippians 1:19-26

For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better. Nevertheless to remain in the flesh is more needful for you. And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith, that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again.

Consecration

- 1. Thank God for the privilege to live the life of Christ.
- 2. Pray for grace to put to death the desires of the flesh.
- 3. Ask for sustaining grace to walk boldly as an overcomer in every area of your life.
- 4. Ask God to surround you with godly people who will help you live for Him.

- 5. Honour God for the presence of the Holy Spirit, who helps you live for Him.
- 6. Ask for the Lord's help to make Christ your chief aim and desire.
- 7. Pray for the restoration of loved ones who have drifted away from Christ.
- 8. Pray that people in your community will be guided to see the surpassing love of Jesus.

- Give thanks to God for His unceasing protection over your life and deliverance from the traps of the world.
- 10. Boldy declare that the life of Christ in you keeps you from every dead situation; declare that you overflow with new life.
- 11. Pray that the resurrection power of Jesus will breathe fresh life into every area of your life that is unfruitful.
- 12. Declare with faith that you overcome by the power of Christ's sacrifice and the testimony of His faithfulness in your life.

Declaration

- 18. Ask the Lord to show you how you can use your work and career to serve His purposes.
- 19. Ask God to bless you and make you a blessing to His church through your work.
- 20. Resist every power and influence that aims to collapse your work and career.

Jesus

- 21. Worship the Lord for giving you the grace to live for Jesus.
- 22. Ask the Lord to teach you how to live by His word.
- 23. Pray that as you come to know Jesus as your resurrection and life, you will experience a mighty revival in your life.
- 24. Ask the Lord to equip you to live boldly for Jesus wherever you go.

Declaration

I declare that I am set apart for Christ. I walk in wisdom, pursue excellence, and experience divine progress. The nations shall witness the glory of God through my testimony. In every place I stand, I shall carry His light. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection 2 Corinthians 5:6-9

So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight. We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him.

Declaration

I boldly declare that I have overcome the world through my faith in Christ. My home is a By the grace of God, I follow the path of righteousness. My hands are clean, my heart is pure, and my eyes are fixed on the One who leads me. I shall become all that He has ordained me to be, and my life shall honour Him in every way. PROCLAIMING JESUS



BOLDLY PROCLAIM CHRIST

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (Romans 1:16)

Morning Reflection Romans 1:8-17

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world. 9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of His Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers, making request if, by some means, now at last I may find a way in the will of God to come to you. For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established— that is, that I may be encouraged together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me. Now I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that I often planned to come to you (but was hindered until now), that I might have some fruit among you also, just as among the other Gentiles. I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to wise and to unwise. So, as much as is in me, I am ready to preach the gospel to you who are in Rome also. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."

Consecration

- 1. Give thanks to the Lord, whose Word is sure and whose truth brings joy that no one can take away.
- Present your heart wholly to God and declare your unshakable trust in His everlasting faithfulness.
- Renounce every doubt and unbelief; proclaim that God's promises to you in Christ are Yes and Amen.
- 4. Affirm with boldness that you are fearfully and wonderfully made, created in Christ Jesus for good works, set apart for His glory.

- 5. Ask the Lord to lead you in paths that reflect His righteousness and bring honour to His name.
- 6. Pray that the eyes of your understanding will be enlightened to perceive the mysteries of God and the treasures hidden in His Word.
- 7. Invite the Holy Spirit to teach you to recognize His promptings and follow His counsel in every area of your life.
- 8. Declare that your steps are ordered by the Lord, and that you are being transformed daily into the likeness of Christ.

- 9. Pray for grace to walk in obedience to God's commands, knowing that the one who walks uprightly dwells securely.
- 10. Declare that you are clothed with the full armour of God and that every strategy of the enemy is rendered powerless against you.
- 11. Speak peace over your household and affirm that no weapon formed against you will prosper, and every tongue raised against you shall be silenced.
- 12. Call upon the Lord to lead you out of every valley of trouble and set your feet upon the rock of deliverance.

Declaration

My trust is in the Lord my God. He directs my steps and watches over my ways. His promises uphold me, His truth establishes me, and His Word in my mouth breaks every chain. I speak life, strength, and purpose into every dry place. In Jesus' name, **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Intercede for the leaders of **Kazakhstan**, that they will govern with humility and justice; pray for spiritual and economic renewal in the land.
- 14. Speak peace over the nation of **Kenya**; ask that every root of conflict be exposed and uprooted by the Prince of Peace.
- 15. Declare that the Church in **Kiribati** stands firm and fruitful, and that the forces of darkness cannot prevail against it.
- 16. Intercede for secret believers in **North Korea** to receive supernatural protection, bold faith, and courage. Pray that God will sustain their hearts, strengthen underground networks, and bring His truth into even the darkest places.
- 17. Ask the Lord to bless the missionary efforts in **South Korea** with fruitfulness; declare a fresh wind of evangelism across the land.

- 18. Ask the Lord to inspire your imagination and awaken your mind to divine strategies that will bring growth and impact in your field.
- 19. Pray for wisdom and excellence in all your responsibilities, that your labour will be pleasing unto the Lord.
- 20. Declare that you will be fruitful even in seasons of difficulty, and that your hands will prosper despite external challenges.
- 21. Ask the Lord to order your steps into assignments and industries where your God-given gifts will bear the most fruit for His Kingdom.

Jesus

- 22. Thank God for drawing you near by the blood of Christ and for placing you in His household with full access to His presence.
- 23. Confess that your life is hidden with Christ in God, and that nothing can separate you from His love.
- 24. Proclaim that Jesus is the Lord over your thoughts, words, decisions, and future; you follow His voice, and a stranger's voice you will not heed.
- 25. Rejoice that the Spirit of the Living God is at work in you—writing His law on your heart, making you bold to witness, and conforming you to Christ in all things.

Declaration

I belong to the Lord and hear His voice. He knows me by name, and I follow where He leads. The Lord is the strength of my heart and my portion forever. His Spirit empowers me to live boldly, love deeply, and proclaim Him without fear. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Acts 4:8-14

Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: If we this day are judged for a good deed done to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well, let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus. And seeing the man who had been healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

Declaration

The Lord is my inheritance and my exceedingly great reward. My life proclaims the power of His Gospel. The voice of the Lord is upon my waters, and I go forth in His strength. No counsel formed against His purpose shall stand. The knowledge of the Lord shall cover the earth through my witness, in Jesus' name. **Amen.**



BE A FAITHFUL WITNESS

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

(Acts 1:8)

Morning Reflection Acts 1:4-8

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Consecration

- 1. Thank the Lord for calling you into His marvelous light and giving you new life in Christ to reflect His righteousness.
- 2. Declare with gratitude that your sins have been forgiven through the blood of Jesus, and no accusation can stand against you.
- 3. Celebrate God's mercy in making you a vessel of His divine nature; affirm your commitment to live to His glory.
- 4. Yield yourself wholly to the Lord and ask Him to make your life a testimony that draws others to Christ.

- 5. Thank God that you are chosen to receive the promise of His Spirit to live as a witness of His kingdom.
- Pray that grace and peace will increase in your life and family as you walk in obedience to His Word.
- 7. Entrust your plans and pursuits to God's care, and ask for His hand to guide you into fruitful paths.
- 8. Ask the Holy Spirit to steer your heart away from all unrighteousness and to teach you to live a life worthy of your calling.

- 9. Declare that the shield of faith extinguishes every fiery dart of fear and intimidation against your witness for Christ.
- 10. Commit your dreams and future to the Lord, trusting Him to guard and establish them according to His will.
- 11. Ask for divine wisdom to recognize and preserve the blessings and influence God has given you.
- 12. In Jesus' name, come against every satanic strategy designed to undermine your faith and your testimony.

Declaration

I am empowered by the Spirit of God to be His witness in every area of my life. I declare that I am consecrated for God's use, guided by His Spirit, and shielded by His grace. Every assignment against my calling fails. I will rise with boldness to proclaim Jesus to my world in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Lift up **Kosovo** and pray that the Church will stand united in its witness to all people in the land.
- 14. Pray that the youth of **Kuwait** will hunger for truth and boldly embrace Christ as Lord.
- 15. Ask God to raise a strong, enduring church in **Kyrgyzstan** that boldly proclaims Christ in society.
- 16. Praise God for the growth of the church in Laos; ask for deep roots of faith among new believers.
- 17. Pray for the people of **Latvia**, that God will meet them at their point of need and bring renewal to the land.

- 18. Ask the Lord to strengthen your ability and increase your effectiveness for greater impact in your profession.
- 19. Pray for insight from God to lead with wisdom and manage your responsibilities with excellence.
- 20. Pray for open eyes to discern divine opportunities for advancement and service.
- 21. Declare that the Spirit of excellence rests on you and that your diligence will bring promotion and favour.

Jesus

- 22. Praise God for the strength to persevere through fasting and prayer as He prepares you for new victories.
- 23. Ask the Lord to train and equip you spiritually for every battle you must face.
- 24. Declare that the power of God is at work in you, both to will and to do His good pleasure.
- 25. Thank the Lord for the grace to recognize potential in others and be a light in every place He sends you.

Declaration

The power of the Holy Spirit is at work in me to be a faithful witness in every sphere of my life. I shine the light of Christ in the nations, in my workplace, and in every encounter. By God's grace, I am equipped, productive, and Spirit-led. I rise daily to fulfil His purpose in Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Matthew 28:16–20

Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Declaration

Today, I proclaim that I am a Spirit-empowered witness for Jesus Christ. I walk in divine purpose, filled with grace and truth. DECLARE HIS GLORY

Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. (Psalm 96:3)

Morning Reflection Psalm 96:1-9

Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! Sing to the Lord, all the earth. Sing to the Lord, bless His name; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised; He is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but the Lord made the heavens. Honor and majesty are before Him; strength and beauty are in His sanctuary. Give to the Lord, O families of the peoples, give to the Lord glory and strength. Give to the Lord the glory due His name; bring an offering, and come into His courts. Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.

Consecration

- 1. Celebrate the Lord, whose Word never fails but prospers in what He sends it to do; give thanks that His will is being fulfilled in your life.
- 2. Ask the Lord to cleanse you and prepare you as a vessel set apart—sanctified and fit for every good work.
- 3. Lay your desires on the altar and pray for grace to detach yourself from anything that chokes your devotion and distracts you from His voice.
- 4. Consecrate yourself afresh and ask for daily grace to walk in love, humility, and unwavering devotion to your Redeemer.

- 5. Pray for a heart that yields quickly and fully to the gentle leading of the Holy Spirit.
- 6. Ask the Lord to open your eyes to the treasures of His Word and align your thoughts, words, and choices to His promises.
- 7. Invite the Spirit of God to lead you step by step on the narrow road that leads to life.
- 8. Pray that when uncertainty arises, the Lord will anchor your heart with peace and strengthen your faith in His unfailing faithfulness.

- 9. Declare boldly that by the blood of Jesus, you and your household are sealed from harm and preserved under divine covering.
- 10. Thank God that no weapon fashioned against you shall prosper; rebuke any assignment of the enemy meant to bring you down.
- 11. Ask the Lord for sharp discernment to detect every hidden trap disguised as opportunity in your work and relationships.
- 12. Proclaim that the Lord is your refuge and fortress, your ever-present help; affirm that you dwell in safety and peace under His wings.

Declaration

The Word of the Lord is my confidence. His promises never fail. I stand secure, bold in faith, and steadfast in hope. I overcome by the Spirit and by the truth, and I am kept in perfect peace because my mind is stayed on Him. In the name of Jesus, I declare that I walk in the counsel of the Lord and not in the path of destruction. **Amen.**

Global Missions

- 13. Pray that the Lord will open wide the gates of **Lebanon** for the proclamation of His truth and grace.
- 14. Ask for discernment and maturity in the Church in **Lesotho**, that the Word of God would prevail over every false doctrine.
- 15. Intercede for the Church in **Liberia**, asking for resources to advance the kingdom of God with boldness.
- 16. Pray for **Libyan** believers to experience God's protection and boldness as they share Christ amidst rebuilding and social transition. Ask the Lord to open hearts and use small gatherings for gospel growth.

Morning Reflection Scripture: John 12:27-36

"Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven, saying, "I have both glorified it and will glorify it again." Therefore the people who stood by and heard it said that it had thundered. Others said, "An angel has spoken to Him." Jesus answered and said, "This voice did not come because of Me, but for your sake. Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out. And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself." This He said, signifying by what death He would die. The people answered Him, "We have heard from the law that the Christ remains forever; and how can You say, 'The Son of Man must be lifted up'? Who is this Son of Man?" Then Jesus said to them, "A little while longer the light is with you. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going. While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become sons of light." These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.

Consecration

- 1. Lay your thoughts, ambitions, and will before the Lord, asking that your heart be purified and your ways aligned with His.
- 2. Pray for mercy to walk uprightly in humility and truth, loving righteousness and hating iniquity.

Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And you are witnesses of these things. Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high."

Consecration

that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,

(Philippians 2:15)

Morning Reflection Hebrews 11:4-16

By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks. By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith. By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God. By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born as many as the stars of the sky in multitude—innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore. These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland. And truly if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return. But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.

Consecration

- 1. Exalt the Lord your Deliverer, who has rescued you from darkness and called you by name to shine as a light in this generation.
- 2. Thank the Father for the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, your daily Guide into truth and righteousness.
- 3. Commit your household to the Lord's keeping—ask for divine protection and that your family will reflect the light of Christ in this generation.
- 4. Declare that this is the day the Lord has made; you will walk in joy and be a living testimony of His goodness.

Guidance

- 5. Give thanks for God's hand that has directed your path and brought you through every season with wisdom and grace.

Consecration

For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men...For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous. Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more, so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Declaration

Morning Reflection Romans 5:12-17

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned— (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law. Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come. But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many. And the gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Consecration

- 1. Praise God for the gift of righteousness and the abundance of grace that sets you apart as a sign and a wonder.
- 2. Declare that God is doing a new thing in your life in this season of prayer and fasting.
- 3. Commit yourself to the Lord and by His grace break free from anything resisting His will in your life.

- 23. Ask the Lord to bless the work of your hands and cause you to enlarge your territory.
- 24. Declare your victory over stagnation and affirm that your season of signs and wonders has come.
- 25. Commit to a deeper walk with Jesus and declare that your heart is fixed on Him.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of His will.....that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ...

Declaration

So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God, while, through the proof of this ministry, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal sharing with them and all men, and by their prayer for you, who long for you because of the exceeding grace of God in you. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!

Consecration

- 1. Give thanks to God for your position of authority in Christ Jesus; declare boldly that you are above and not beneath.
- Celebrate the grace of God that enables you to walk with excellence in both character and conduct.
- 3. Yield yourself fully to God's purpose, inviting Him to stretch and use you in greater dimensions in ministry, career, and education.
- 4. Pray that in this season of waiting, your strength will be renewed, and you will receive fresh grace for every need.

- 5. Ask for divine grace to remain consistent in the meditation of God's Word, finding direction for your daily life.
- Pray for increased spiritual capacity and boldness to pursue God's assignments for your life.
- 7. Pray that God guide you through Scripture to better understand His love and the vastness of His plans for your increase.

Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, but those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

Declaration

He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken. Evil shall slay the wicked...The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.

Declaration

You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Consecration

And what do you have that you did not receive? Now if you did indeed receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it?

Declaration

TRANSFORMED BY HIS GRACE

"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me."

(1 Corinthians 15:10)

Morning Reflection 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. 8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. Therefore, whether it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

Consecration

- 11. Declare that no weapon formed against you shall prosper; speak divine exemption from harm and evil.
- 12. Commit your entire day into God's hands, asking for supernatural safety and favor.

- 17. Speak light over **Slovakia**; pray that cities will be turned to the Lord through mighty revivals.

Work and Career

- 18. Pray for discernment and courage to make tough decisions that drive growth and progress.
- 19. Thank the Lord for opening new doors of opportunity; declare divine acceleration in your endeavors.
- 20. Call forth creativity, diligence, and excellence to turn obstacles into breakthroughs.
- 21. Affirm that your efforts are blessed and fruitful because you work under divine grace.

Jesus

- 22. Ask the Lord to anoint your hands with power to produce and prosper.
- 23. Pray that your faith will rise to pursue and fulfill your divine assignment through prayer, fasting, and study.
- 24. Declare open heavens over your life, your family, your church, and the nation.
- 25. Thank Jesus for the grace to be a blessing and a change agent in your generation.

Declaration

WORKING THE WORKS OF GOD

Then they said to Him, 'What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?' Jesus answered and said to them, 'This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.' (John 6:28-29)

Morning Reflection John 6:22-29

On the following day, when the people who were standing on the other side of the sea saw that there was no other boat there, except that one which His disciples had entered, and that Jesus had not entered the boat with His disciples, but His disciples had gone away alone— however, other boats came from Tiberias, near the place where they ate bread after the Lord had given thanks— when the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, nor His disciples, they also got into boats and came to Capernaum, seeking Jesus. And when they found Him on the other side of the sea, they said to Him, "Rabbi, when did You come here?" Jesus answered them and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him." Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?" Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

Consecration

- 7. Pray that the young people in your family will find their identity and purpose in Christ.
- 8. Ask the Lord to guide your thoughts, time, and resources into actions that glorify His name and expand His kingdom..

If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works...Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?

Declaration

By faith in Jesus, I am empowered to work the works of God. No fear, no hindrance, no lack shall stop me. I move forward with divine authority, spiritual boldness, and fruitful obedience. I work while it is day and fulfill all that God has assigned to me. In Jesus' name. Amen.



EQUIPPED FOR EVERY GOOD WORK

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

Morning Reflection 2 Timothy 3:10-17

But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance, persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra—what persecutions I endured. And out of them all the Lord delivered me. Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived. But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Consecration

- 1. Praise God for giving you the Scriptures as a divine tool for transformation and empowerment.
- 2. Affirm that you walk with the Lord daily, He equips you for every good work.
- Ask the Lord to refine your character through His truth so that you become a vessel fit for His use.

- 16. Pray for **Suriname's** Church to rise as a bulwark of prayer, integrity, and grassroots transformation, modeling Christ's compassion and wisdom in daily life.

- 17. Declare that you are equipped to do your work heartily as unto the Lord, bringing Him glory.
- 18. Ask for divine ideas, integrity, and skill that distinguish you in your field.
- 19. Pray for influence in your workplace to mentor and disciple others through your example.
- 20. Commit your daily tasks to the Lord, trusting that He works through you to accomplish good.

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead...make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

Declaration

CALLED TO GOOD WORKS

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)

Morning Reflection Ephesians 2:1-10

And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Consecration

- 1. Praise God for His promise to flood your heart with peace as you consecrate your life to Him.
- 2. Confess every moment of spiritual complacency and withheld sacrifice; ask the Lord for cleansing and renewal.
- 3. Ask for a heart that passionately loves God, one that offers the first and best without reluctance.
- 4. Declare that as you remain in His presence, His peace will overflow like a river into every part of your soul.

- Ask the Lord to sharpen your ability to hear and obey His voice without delay or confusion.
- 6. Thank the Holy Spirit for being your ever-present teacher and guide; invite Him to lead you in authentic worship and holy living.
- 7. Declare that God's peace governs your heart and mind as you walk in step with His will.

- 15. Intercede for the nation of **Syria**, asking for a divine revelation of Jesus Christ to flood the land. Pray for spiritual growth and witness among believers.
- 16. Pray for the youth of **Taiwan**, that they may become bold and mature disciples of Christ, fully dedicated to living out the call of God on their lives.

- 17. Declare that every career decision you make aligns with God's will and leads to advancement, influence, and excellence.
- 18. Ask the Lord to open doors to influential platforms and strategic opportunities in your field.
- 19. Request grace to maintain a healthy balance between in all areas of your life work, family, health and relationships.
- 20. Proclaim that your finances are shielded from every devourer and that you joyfully present costly offerings to the Lord.

Jesus

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

Declaration

Everlasting God, You are not a man that You should lie. I trust in Your call over my life. I receive grace to honor You with my time, my talent, and my treasure. Make me a witness to the lost and a light in the darkness. As I walk in the good works prepared for me, may Your name be glorified through me. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**



THE FATHER'S BUSINESS

And He said to them, 'Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?' (Luke 2:49)

Morning Reflection Luke 2:41-50

His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it; but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him. Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers. So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously." And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

Consecration

- 1. Thank God for the cleansing power of the blood of Jesus that purifies you from all unrighteousness.
- 2. Thank God for the opportunity to do the Father's business to serve in His kingdom with your life on earth.
- 3. Declare that you walk in the Spirit consistently and will not gratify the desires of the flesh.
- 4. Seek a deeper fellowship with the Holy Spirit as you dedicate yourself afresh in this season of consecration.

- 5. Submit all your plans and ambitions to God; ask for grace to live as a living sacrifice, pleasing unto Him.
- 6. Invite the Holy Spirit to make you sensitive to His leading and help you recognize divine doors of opportunity.
- 7. Ask for strength and wisdom to promptly obey the promptings of the Spirit.
- 8. Declare that as you surrender to God's will, you walk in divine wisdom, insight, and clarity.

- 9. Commit all your labors for the Lord into His hands; ask for divine protection against every plan of the enemy.

In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know." Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields...And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life...I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored..."

Declaration

Covenant-Keeping God, I lift up Your holy name. You are full of mercy, truth, and righteousness. From Your Word, I draw wisdom to succeed and grace to honor You with all that I am. Make me a channel of blessing and a witness of Your power and goodness. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**



DOING GREATER WORKS

Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. (John 14:12)

Morning Reflection John 14:12-18

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. "If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

Consecration

- 1. Thank God for the blessing of being able to do greater works by the Spirit of God.
- 2. Pray for sanctification and the grace to overcome every habit or sin that will hinder your ability to freely do greater works.
- 3. Ask God to set your family apart for divine intervention and supernatural breakthroughs.
- 4. Thank the Lord for this time of prayer and fasting; declare that divine strength is yours beyond 40 Days of Power.

- 5. Praise God for helping you discern His leading throughout this season.
- 6. Ask the Lord for unwavering trust in His plans and purposes, even when the path is unclear.
- 7. Declare that the Lord is your refuge and strength against every scheme of the adversary.
- 8. Pray for divine favor to always be positioned rightly—at the right place, at the right time.

- 9. Commit every aspect of your day and the days ahead into God's hands; declare that His angels have charge over you and your household to keep you from harm.
- 10. Rebuke the spirit of fear and every lie that seeks to derail your faith.
- 11. Ask the Lord to arise on your behalf—to fight your battles and reward those who bless you.
- 12. Plead God's covering over your family, property, and endeavors; receive His deliverance and protection.

Declaration
